Composition Each 2 mL contains Furosemide 20 mg

Indication Edema

Acute pulmonary edema

Congestive heart failure (CHF) and chronic

renal failure

Dosage and administration: Edema: The initial dose is 20 to 40 mg IM or

> IV. If needed, another dose may be given in the same manner 2 hours later. The dose may be raised by 20 mg and given no sooner than 2 hours after previous dose, until desired diuretic effect is obtained. This dose should be given once or twice daily.

> Acute pulmonary edema: The initial dose is 40 mg IV (over 1 to 2 minutes). If response is not satisfactory within 1 hour, increase to 80 mg IV.

> Congestive heart failure (CHF) and chronic renal failure: The dose is 2 to 2.5 g/day or more. For IV bolus injection, the maximum dose should not exceed 1 g/day given over

30 minutes.

Adverse reaction: Fluid and electrolyte imbalance including

> hyponatremia, hypokalemia and hypochloremic alkalosis, particularly after large doses or

prolonged administration.

Contraindication: Acute renal failure with anuria, hyponatremia,

hypokalemia, impaired renal or hepatic function.

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
