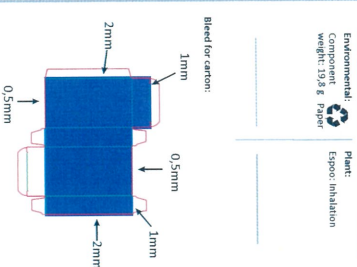

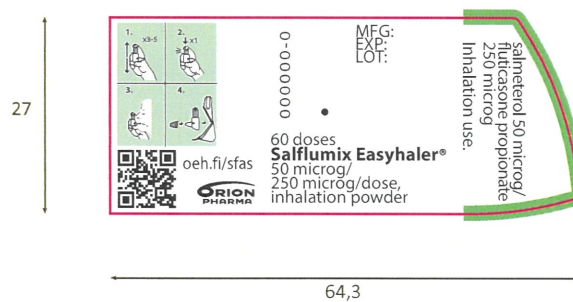

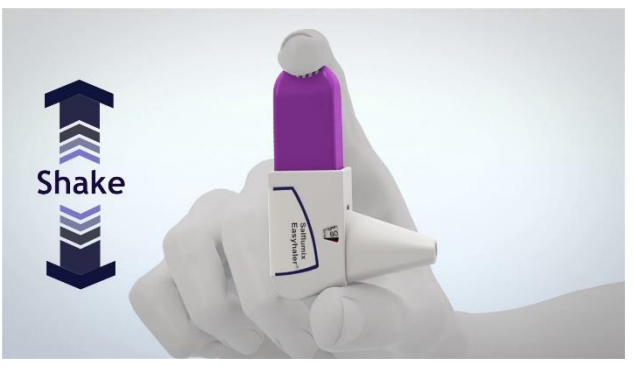

		This device is a metered dose, dry powder inhaler for the treatment of respiratory diseases like asthma or COPD. The inhaler comes in a foil bag. Take the inhaler out of it only when you are ready to start using it for the first time.

		There is a dust cap for the inhaler which prevents the inhaler from preloading.
		Before you start taking a dose remove the dust cap. Thereafter, place the inhaler between your forefinger and your thumb.
Shake		Shake the inhaler in an upright position 3-5 times.

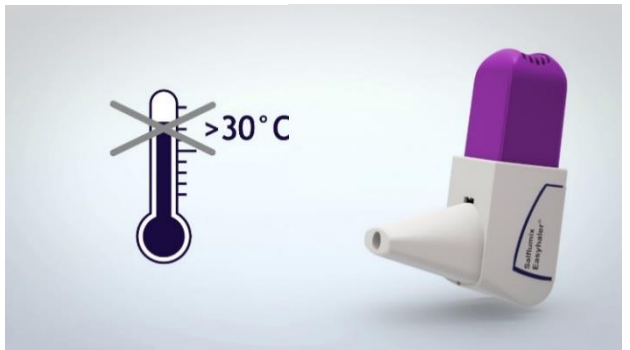

Click		Press down until you hear a click. Then let it go back to its original position.
Inhale		Breathe out normally, place the mouthpiece in your mouth, between your teeth and close your lips tightly around the mouthpiece. Take a strong deep breath. Take the inhaler out of your mouth, hold your breath for at least 5 seconds. Then breathe out normally. If you need to take more than one dose, repeat the steps from Shake onwards. After all doses put the dust cap back on the mouthpiece.
Rinse Spit it out		After taking your dose, rinse your mouth with water and spit it out.

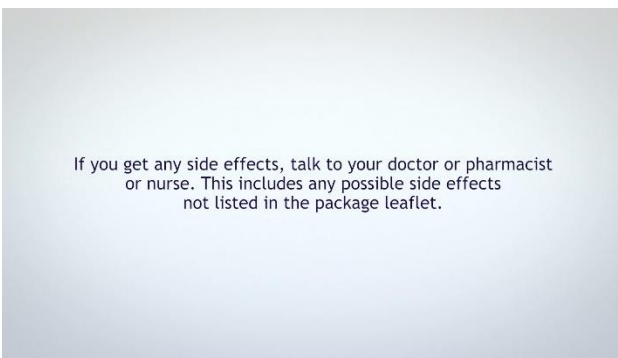

		You should clean the inhaler regularly with a dry cloth.
>30°C		After opening the foil bag do not store above +30 C and store protected from moisture.
		If you click the inhaler by accident, or if you have clicked it more than once, or you breathe out into it, tap the mouthpiece to empty the powder onto a table top or the palm of your hand. Then start again from the beginning.

NOTE: The counter turns after every 5th click.		A dose counter shows you how many doses are left in the inhaler. The counter turns after every 5th click. When the counter turns red, it's time to get a new prescription.
